ONE LIFE

In 1938, Nicholas Winton, a mild-mannered British stockbroker became increasingly unsettled by the news of what was happening in continental Europe. After a spur-of-the-moment decision to join friends in Prague to help a growing number of refugees, his life and the lives of hundreds of Jewish children facing the threat of Hitler's regime changed forever.

Sir Anthony Hopkins masterfully portrays the deeply humble and reclusive Winton of the 1980s. When asked to declutter his office, Nicholas uncovers the long-buried folders noting names of all children he saved, sparking memories of his wartime experiences. Jumping between past and present, this scrapbook triggers a series of events that culminate in a celebration of his life-saving achievements when the BBC invites him to a television program with surprising consequences.

A story that deeply resonates in our time, as we continue to grapple with war, refugee crises, and growing antisemitism. *One Life* offers a moving portrait and a reminder of how one person can make a difference.

THE CRITIC

An all-star cast lead this wickedly mischievous reimagining of Anthony Quinn's novel *Curtain Call*. The year is 1936. As the new steward of London's Daily Chronicle, David Brooke (the always suburb Mark Strong) seeks to revive the financially troubled newspaper. Enter Jimmy Erskine (a brilliant Sir Ian McKellen) the Daily Chronicle's most famous and feared theatre critic of the age and a young actress, Nina Land (the sublime Gemma Arterton) who is devastated by Jimmy's recent negative review of her performance.

Whilst the three may have little in common at first, things change as WWII looms with fascism on the rise, the three become entangled in a whodunnit entering a devilish pact as their strange triangle of deception weaves tighter, culminating in a devastatingly deadly web of blackmail and betrayal. Treading the boards with a scintillating tale of ambition and deceit, *The Critic* brims with five-star intrigue propelled by a killer cast offering a cunning reminder that the pen is truly mightier than the sword.

THE GREAT ESCAPER

Starring the inimitable Sir Michael Caine and the late Glenda Jackson, we follow the remarkable true story of a war veteran who makes a dash across the channel for the D-Day celebrations.

The summer of 2014 marked the 70th Anniversary of the D-Day Landings - octogenarian Bernie Jordan (Caine) made global headlines as he staged a "great escape" from his care home to join fellow war veterans on a beach in Normandy, commemorating their fallen comrades. It was a story that captured the imagination of the world. Bernie seemed to embody the defiant "can-do" spirit of a generation that was fast disappearing. Bernie's Big Adventure only spanned a mere 48 hours, but it also marked the culmination of his 60-year marriage to Rene (played by Glenda Jackson, who passed shortly after production concluded) - the story celebrates their love with a touching sincerity.

A bitter-sweet script deployed with emotional gravitas by the impactable performances from Caine and Jackson, this classical narrative explores the horrors of war and reality of aging with wit and a very big heart.

THE WIFE AND HER HOUSE HUSBAND

As their contentious divorce moves towards an end, Cassie (Laura Bayston) and Matthew (Laurence Spellman) receive a surprise reminder from their past - a letter they wrote to each other as young lovers, containing instructions for a potential future separation. The letter encourages them to create meaningful experiences that will allow them to part ways with love and not bitterness.

Over the course of four intense days, the couple struggle to reconcile their lingering feelings with the reality of their situation. As they reconnect, they must grapple with the question of whether they can truly move on from their painful past and build a future together.

An impressive piece of filmmaking, the sparse shooting aesthetic allows the raw emotion of the narrative to be the primary focus. Showcasing an honest, tender script navigating the highs and lows of married life, Marcus Markou crafts an engrossing and engaging drama fuelled by solid central performances.

MARCUS MARKOU

Marcus Markou is an independent filmmaker - who self-distributed his debut feature film, *Papadopoulos and Sons*, in 2013 by staging his own cinema release, to great success.

He has written two plays, *Age-Sex-Location* (2004) and *Ordinary Dreams* (2009), and his short films *Two Strangers Who Meet Five Times* (2017) and *Office Song* (2019) have notched up over 100 festival screenings between them and over 20 award wins. *Two Strangers Who Meet Five Times* became a viral hit on YouTube and went from 20k views in April 2021 to over 3 million views in just a few months.

In 2014 he was nominated by the London Critics Circle Awards for Breakthrough British Filmmaker.

WICKED LITTLE LETTERS

A truly scandalous tale from the 1920s. Olivia Colman and Jessie Buckley reunite playing neighbours who get on each other's nerves in this pitch-dark comedy following a small English town where residents start receiving anonymous, expletive-laden letters!

Edith Swan (Colman) a pious pillar of the community just so happens to be on the receiving end of these character assassination mail drops. Law enforcement reluctantly investigate but Edith harbours a theory that her neighbour Rose (Buckley) might be the culprit.

Rose is the opposite of Edith, loud and brash, and when police arrest Edith assuming guilt due to her "loose moral character," it does not sit well with Police Officer Gladys Moss and with superiors unwilling to listen, she gathers a group of resourceful female volunteers to get to the bottom of this mailout mystery.

This post marked whodunnit is fuelled by the stellar cast, including razor sharp turns from Colman and Buckley with support by Timothy Spall, the narrative offers astute commentary on misogyny, hypocrisy, and repression while delivering a profoundly stifling social commentary that is brimming with blush worthy curse words and purse-clutching performances.

DANCE FIRST

Academy Award-winning filmmaker James Marsh (*Man on a Wire*, *The Theory of Everything*) brings the life of Literary genius Samuel Beckett to the screen. Beckett, played with gusto by Gabriel Byrne, lived a life of many parts: Parisian bon vivant, WWII Resistance fighter, Nobel Prize-winning playwright, philandering husband, recluse. Despite all the adulation that came his way he was a man acutely aware of his own failings.
